Mr. Godin joined SHEEO as an associate vice president in January 2019. He leads a Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation grant focused on the National Student Clearinghouse's Postsecondary Data Partnership (PDP), providing data-related technical assistance to Jobs for the Future Student Success Centers and their colleges.

Before joining SHEEO, Mr. Godin served as Associate Vice Chancellor for Research & Analytics for the Florida College System (FCS). In this role, he provided leadership and technical assistance for quality data submission and use to Florida's 28 community colleges, Florida Department of Education staff, and legislators. Specifically, he collaborated with state committees and agencies, led the analysis of data metrics for the Florida College System's performance-based incentive program, and developed state-wide and college level dashboards for senior college administrators.

Prior to the FCS, Mr. Godin worked for two national higher education associations, the Association for Institutional Research (AIR) and the Council of Independent Colleges (CIC). He holds a B.S. in psychology and sociology from the University of Richmond, a M.Ed. in higher education from the College of William and Mary, and is a Ph.D. candidate in higher education at Florida State University.
