RECOMMENDATIONS



- Signage about expectations for personal hygiene, physical distancing and masks for students, faculty and staff needs to be posted in buildings.
- 2. Add information about student mask requirements to the Code of Conduct.
- 3. Greek housing and life: Follow grouping and venue guidance for housing, dining, and activities. If single-occupancy rooms are unavailable, then the Greek organization must have a place to isolate a sick student until 3 days after no fever without fever reducing medicines and at least 14 days from onset of symptoms, and quarantine any exposed roommate who is not sick for 14 days.
- 4. Student orientation sessions can be held if IHE is able to follow the grouping and venue size guidelines with individual student and enhanced cleaning protocols.
