
A Bold Approach to Reshape Higher Education


The Importance of Our Mission:

Higher education continues to pay off for students. Unemployment rates are lowest and median weekly earnings are highest for those who earn postsecondary credentials. As achievement gaps persist for students of color and low-income students, not having a postsecondary credential can exasperate income inequality and further exasperate achievement gaps.

Higher education is becoming more expensive. Net tuition from higher institutions accounts for over half of all education revenue in some states. Our most vulnerable students begin to be priced out as the price of tuition rises. With the Institute, state leaders and researchers will be armed with the training and research to examine and resolve the equity issues in their own state.
