









LEAP 2020: IN-DEMAND OCCUPATIONS

 - Confusing policy





Data Strategy

- Availability of data
- Strengths and weaknesses of a dataset
- Alignment of data using crosswalks and limitations due to redactions

Methodology Strategy

- Ratios, rounding, significant digits
- Occupation groups that are not as well-served by the methodology




