

Admission Criteria (associate's degree)







- Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education








Tech Center Courses Approved for Transfer

Oklahoma Military Articulations

- Working with military subject matter experts in order to develop a military transfer matrix for the State of Oklahoma.
- Qualified faculty members are nominated to evaluate military course work for inclusion on the System-wide matrix.
- This matrix will provide transparency to students and in many cases publish what institutions are already awarding.
- Collected Oklahoma specific ACE recommendation data to enhance the matrix.
- Eligible students will receive Credit for Prior Learning (PLA) for training received serving in the military.



Credit for Prior Learning

Oklahoma recognizes the importance of accepting credit for prior learning (PLA) and utilizes several acceptable methods for validating credit earned outside the traditional classroom setting.

VALIDATING PLA CREDIT

ONE:

ACE Recommendations

TWO:

Use of the systemwide assessment inventory of industry, technical, and other assessments associated with a Military occupation.

THREE:

Univ. of State NY's College Credit Recommendation Service (CCRS) FOUR:

Standard exams such as AP*, CLEP, and DANTES

*State Regents' policy requires credit to be granted for a 3 or higher on the AP exam

Credit for Prior Learning is transcripted when the student completes 12 credit hours at the awarding institution.

FIVE:

PLA credit awarded and transcripted by another institution SIX:

Portfolio using CAEL or other standardized guidelines

SEVEN:

Courses delivered on the main campus and transcripted by the Oklahoma School of Science and Mathematics (OSSM).

EIGHT:
