



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

Unfortunately, the significant changes required by the transition to the new system have resulted in a delayed release and compressed timeline for filling out the form. While Federal Student Ad has not yet amounced the structure of the structur the exact date when the FAFSA will be released, it will not be earlier than December 1, 2023 two months later than in a typical year.

This compressed timeline could most disadvantage students and families who need greater summer to complete the FAFSA – and who have the most to pain from filling out the form
