
- 2012 legislative mandate
- A <u>block</u> of 30 credit hours of college-level general education coursework that transfers seamlessly to all Indiana public institutions and some private institutions

RESPONSIBILITIES OF PRIMARY POSTSECONDARY PROVIDERS

- Track and report data on ICC earners to the Commission
- Deliver at least 15 of the 30 credit hours of ICC coursework
 - Best practice: Deliver at least one course in each competency.
- Coordinate courses with secondary providers
- Maintenance of high school ICC courses in My College Core
- Award a certificate to all students who earn the ICC

RESPONSIBILITIES OF APPROVED HIGH SCHOOL PROVIDERS

- Partner with one Indiana public institution to offer the ICC
- Commit to using the Commission's communication and marketing materials for the ICC: <u>My College Core</u>
- Post <u>required ICC content</u> on the school website
- Work with Commission Outreach Coordinators to maximize FAFSA filings






STATEWIDE OR SYSTEMWIDE APPOLICY IN 2014



- Advanced Placement (AP) courses can be used to complete the ICC.
- A student must earn a minimum of 3 on an AP exam to earn credit that applies to the ICC. Each provider has a list of equivalencies that will count toward their courses here: <u>AP Equivalency Database</u>
- Each institution has the right to reevaluate course credit given by the primary postsecondary provider according to their institutional policies and equivalencies








MY COLLEGE CORE PLANNING TOOL

- Launched August 1, 2023
- Created to be a one-stop shop for all things Indiana College Core
- Planning tool shows college-level coursework, including dual credit, dual enrollment, AP, and CLEP
- Student can email their plan to parents and counselors
- Meant to be for planning purposes, <u>not a scheduling tool or transcript</u>
- Built-in toolkit of resources for high schools

Do you want to get a head start on college? The Indiana College Core allows high school students to earn 30 general education credits that can be transferred as a block to any public college or university in Indiana, as well as some private institutions. In other words, students who earn the College Core in high school may alread be finished with their first year of college at a fraction of the cost. 
What is FAFSA?

The Free Application For Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) is the most important document for determining if you're eligible for financial aid — money to help you pay for education and training beyond high school. The easiest wa to file the FAFSA is online at FAFSA.gov.






