












Why increasing educational attainment is critical for Michigan's and North Carolina's economic future











The Office of Sixty by 30 was created to coordinate State efforts to meet the goal Governor Whitmer set in her 2019 State of the State address: that by 2030, sixty percent of Michigan's working-age adults would have a postsecondary degree or credential.



Our Why:

Students of color and students from low-income households are more likely to stop out due to external factors and a history of inequitable policies beyond their control.

Michigan

HIGHLIGHT: 37 of 50 hot jobs typical education level will require a bachelor's degree or higher

HIGHLIGHT: 7 of 50 hot jobs typical education level will require an associate degree or professional certificate

HIGHLIGHT: Unemployment rates for those with only a high school diploma are **2.7 times higher** than those with a bachelor's degree.

Michiganders think a degree is somewhat important but not worth the money










America's demographic curve has shifted






Adult learners are the linchpin in the attainment equation


