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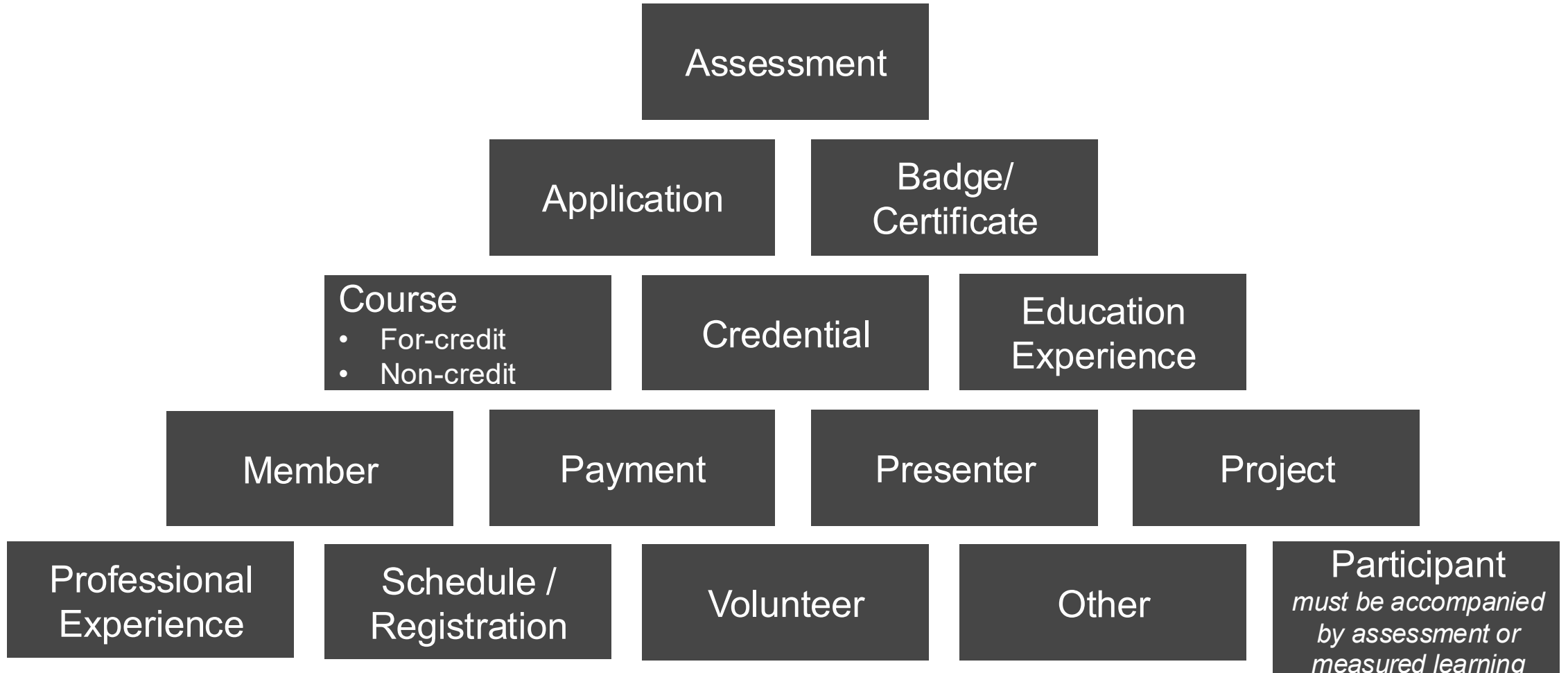

- ▶ Oklahoma State Regents' recognized approved methods
 - ▶ ACE Guide to Evaluation
 - ▶ Use of systemwide inventory of approved military training
 - ▶ The University of the State of New York's National College Credit Recommendation Service
 - ▶ Standardized examinations (AP, CLEP, DANTES)
 - ▶ Degree-relevant CPL awarded and transcribed by other accredited, degree granting institutions
 - ▶ Assessment of student portfolio using CAEL or other standardized guidelines



CPL CONTINUED

➤ Methods continued

- Courses completed and transcribed by the Oklahoma School of Science and Mathematics
- International Baccalaureate Organization Diploma Program
- Institutionally prepared assessments
- Apprenticeship, certifications, professional licensure

- Based on student learning outcomes
- Searchable transfer database

MILITARY TRANSFER INVENTORY

- Facilitated meetings between military SME and faculty
- Recognition of ACE recommendations
- Examples
 - Warrant Officer Candidate – 9 credit hours
 - Air Defense Artillery Captain's Career Course - 12 credit hours
 - Telecommunications Specialist, Class A – 3 credit hours



INDUSTRY RECOGNIZED CREDENTIALS

- Credentials earned through industry training
- Must be nationally recognized credential
- Typically aligns with Associate in Applied Science programs
- Examples
 - CLEET – 12 – 29 credit hours
 - Adobe Certified Associate – 24 credit hours
 - AutoCAD – 15 credit hours
 - CompTIA A+ – 3 credit hours

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Reach Higher: Oklahoma's Adult Degree Completion Initiative





REACH HIGHER: FlexFinish

- ▶ Adult degree completion with flexible, non-traditional formats
- ▶ 7 universities
 - ▶ Bachelor of Science in Organizational Leadership
- ▶ 14 community colleges
 - ▶ Associate in Arts in Enterprise Development
 - ▶ Associate in Science in Enterprise Development





HOW RHFF WORKS

➤ Admission Criteria

- Have a minimum of 18 credit hours earned.
- Have a minimum of 2.0 graduation/retention GPA in past college course work.
- Satisfy all institutional requirements for completion of remedial coursework.
- Once a student is approved for admission, the applicant will be notified in writing and assigned an advisor or contact person. The student should then complete an individual degree plan with the advisor at the home institution.





➤ Benefits to students

- Dedicated coordinator
- Assistance with financial aid application and registration at home institution or sister institutions for needed courses
- Emergency Funding
- Direction to other services on campus and in the local community

REACH HIGHER: DirectComplete





HOW RHDC WORKS

➤ Admission Criteria

- Students aged 25 and older
- Have 75% (45 credit hours) toward associate degree or 50% (60 credit hours) toward bachelor's degree
- Minimum 2.0 GPA in previous course work
- No remediation needed
